- ✓ Immigration and Custom Enforcement (ICE) has begun immigration raids to detain immigrant individuals and families from Central America who have been denied refugee status. Virginia is a state with large immigration populations including those from Central America and as such It is imperative that our immigrant communities know and understand how to exercise their rights during interactions with immigration and law enforcement officials.
- ✓ To inform on the political context influencing DHS's targeted enforcement policy towards Central American refugees as well as provide an overview of said policy.
